Dominican Republic adopts IFRS for SMEs effective 1 July 2014

From 1 July 2014 the *IFRS for SMEs* in its entirety will be required for all large and medium-sized unlisted companies in the Dominican Republic. Prior to 2014, in the process of gradually implementing the *IFRS for SMEs*, 13 of the 35 sections of the *IFRS for SMEs* were not mandatory.
